

- Connected to health insurance


Areas for potential improvement:

- Exits to PH destinations




Total System Entries and Homelessness for the First Time

 - * "First Time" per HUD = no entries in ES, SH, TH or PH in the previous 24 months









Median Length of Time Homeless




Overall Reduction in PIT Homelessness



Annual Counts Sheltered Persons in HMIS



Permanent Housing Retention


Percentage of People in Permanent Housing
