Qualifying renters and landlords impacted by COVID-19 are now eligible for 100% of rent and utilities owed.

The County of Santa Clara in collaboration with community partners can help you learn about and apply for COVID-19 emergency rental assistance programs.

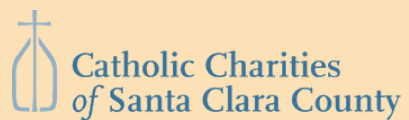
Types of information for tenants to bring:

- Contact information for your landlord and/or manager (name, phone number, email, and address (whatever you have))
- For each adult in the rented unit:
 - 1) proof of identity (like a passport, drivers' license, or consulate ID);
 - 2) proof of income (like pay stubs);
 - 3) proof of rent (like your lease); and
 - 4) proof of address (like a utility or medical bill)

Are you behind on rent?



There is help. Emergency rent relief is available.

If you're an income qualified tenant financially impacted by COVID-19 and unable to pay rent, or if you are a landlord who has not received rent because your tenants are financially affected by the pandemic, you may be eligible for emergency rent relief.

How do I know if I qualify?

Renters whose households are unable to pay rent, financially impacted by COVID-19, and make up to 80% of the Area Median Income (AMI) may be eligible, regardless of immigration status.
